Description of the Land along the River. Beginning at upper corner, La River, then down Stream -

- 1<sup>st</sup> Mile First quality of Bottom land, suitable for meadows, and for growing indian corn, tobacco, hemp, &c. to great perfection; Timber, Oak, Hickory, Sugar, Ash, Walnut, Pawpaw, &c.
- 2<sup>d</sup> " Very little Bottom land on the River, this side, the hills being close to the bank. Soil generally rich; Timber, Oak, Hickory, Sugar, Ash, &c.
- 3<sup>d</sup> " There is good Bottom land on the River, this side, very suitable for making meadow, and raising indian corn, tobacco, hemp, &c. to great perfection; well timbered with Oak, Hickory, Ash, Walnut, Sugar, Locust.
- 4<sup>th</sup> " Land 1<sup>st</sup> rate, suitable as above; Timber, Oak, Walnut, Hickory, Sugar, Locust, &c.
- 5<sup>th</sup> " First rate Bottom land, suitable for meadow, raising hemp, tobacco, corn, &c.; Timber, Oak, Hickory, Sugar, Ash, Walnut and Locust.
- 6<sup>th</sup> " Same as last mile - suitable for meadow, and raising corn, hemp and tobacco, &c.
- 7<sup>th</sup> " At 45 chains, lower corner of the Township, the hill is close to the bank, but the soil is rich, and timbered with Hickory, Sugar, Ash, Walnut, Locust, Oak, &c.
